Food for Good Raffle—Official Rules

1. The Food for Good Raffle (the “Raffle”) is conducted by Robin Hood Foundation (“Robin Hood”), a New York not-for-profit corporation.
2. No purchase required for entry. Entries may be made by registering to attend the Food for Good Event on November 12, 2009 (the “Event”) or by emailing foodforgood@robinhood.org. **All entries must include a valid email address.** By entering the Raffle, you agree to be bound by these Official Rules as well as any other posted notices or oral announcements made at the Event. All decisions of Robin Hood regarding this Raffle are binding in all respects.
3. The Raffle is only open to legal residents of the United States who are at least 18 years old as of the date of entry, except officers, directors, and employees of Robin Hood or any other party associated with the development or administration of this Raffle, and the immediate family (i.e., parents, children, siblings, spouse) and persons residing in the same household, as such individuals. The Raffle is void outside the U.S. and where prohibited.
4. Prize: There will be one prize winner. The prize is a one-week stay at the Four Seasons Residence Club Aviara in Carlsbad, California (the “Four Seasons Aviara”). The prize includes: a seven-night (from March 20, 2010 to March 27, 2010) stay in a two-bedroom villa at the Four Seasons Aviara (can accommodate up to eight people). Air and ground transportation, meals, in-room or other personal charges at lodging, spa services, golf fees, telephone calls, gratuities and all other expenses are not included. The winner and travel companions must be available to travel during the specified period. The approximate retail value of the prize is \$8,400.
5. Potential winner selection will be conducted by random drawing at the Event. If the potential winner is not present at the Event when his/her name is announced, he/she will be notified by email. If the potential winner does not respond to the notification email within 48 hours from the date Robin Hood first tries to notify him/her or the notification email is returned as undeliverable, such potential winner forfeits all rights to receive the prize and an alternate potential winner may be selected. Upon contacting a potential winner and determining that he/she has met all eligibility requirements, including without limitation the execution of required waivers, releases and disclaimers, such individual will be declared the “winner” of the Raffle.
6. The winner must provide his or her social security number or taxpayer identification number in order to claim the prize. **The winner shall be responsible for all federal, state and local income and other taxes, if any.**
7. The prize is not transferable or redeemable for cash. Any portion of the prize that is not used is forfeited. There are no substitutions for the prize except by Robin Hood, in which case a prize of equal or greater value will be substituted.
8. By entering the Raffle, each entrant releases and discharges Robin Hood and its directors, officers, employees, agents and representatives (collectively, “Sponsor Entities”) from any and all liability in connection with the Raffle, including without limitation legal claims, costs, injuries, losses or damages, demands or actions of any kind (including without limitation personal injuries, death, damage to or loss or destruction of property) (collectively, “Claims”). Except where prohibited: (i) acceptance of the prize constitutes a release by any winner of the Sponsor Entities of any and all Claims in connection with the administration of the Raffle; (ii) any potential winner may be required to sign an affidavit of eligibility (including social security number); and (iii) any potential winner and travel companions (if applicable) may be required to execute releases of the Sponsor Entities from any and all liability with respect to the use of the prize.
9. ROBIN HOOD MAKES NO WARRANTIES, REPRESENTATIONS OR GUARANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, IN FACT OR IN LAW, AS REGARDS THE RAFFLE OR THE MERCHANTABILITY, QUALITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE REGARDING THE PRIZE OR ANY COMPONENT OF THE PRIZE.
10. The Raffle is subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations. Issues concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these Official Rules shall be governed by the laws of the State of New York. All disputes arising out of or connected with the Raffle will be resolved exclusively by a state or federal court located in New York, New York. Should there be a conflict between the laws of the State of New York and any other laws, the conflict will be resolved in favor of the laws of the State of New York.
